The **EASTWOOD JACK STAND SET** features a wide-base design for added stability and security when performing under vehicle work. Constructed of fully welded, heavy gauge fabricated steel and heavy castings for rugged reliability.

- (2) Cast steel, ratcheting Support Posts (A)
- (2) Welded Steel Frames with Ratchet Release (B)

- Use only on a flat, level and firm surface. DO NOT attempt to use on gravel, hot asphalt, sand, earth or any other unstable material.
- DO NOT exceed rated weight capacity per set.
- Use only as a pair, as supplied, to support one vehicle end.
- · Vehicle weight must be centered on support pad of Post.


 To avoid possible personal injury keep hands and fingers free of moving parts when lowering the Jack Stand Posts.

ASSEMBLY

- Remove Frames (A) from carton and place on a firm surface.
- Remove Support Posts (B) from carton and place ends into openings at top of Frames (A). Be sure to orient the ratchet teeth toward the Ratchet Pawl.

▲ CAUTION PINCH HAZARD! To avoid possible personal injury keep hands and fingers free of moving parts when lowering the Jack Stand Posts.

 Using a suitable drift and hammer, bend the Retaining Tabs of each Frame inward toward the recess in each Post to prevent the Posts from pulling out (FIG 1).



OPERATION

- Jack vehicle to 2" above desired height with proper jacking equipment.
- Raise the Jack Stand Posts by pulling upward and allowing the Pawl to catch the ratchet teeth. **NOTE:** Raise both Posts to the same height.

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- Always consult an authorized manufacturer's service manual or instructional materials on the particular vehicle being supported for the proper jacking procedures and vehicle support points before using these Jack Stands.
- Use only on a flat, level and firm surface. DO NOT attempt to use on gravel, hot asphalt, sand, earth or any other unstable material.
- DO NOT exceed rated weight capacity per set.
- Use only as a pair as supplied to support one vehicle end.
- Vehicle weight load must be centered on support pad of Post.
- Place each Jack Stand under the indicated jacking points and lower the jack to allow the full weight of the vehicle to be supported by the Jack Stands.

REMOVING JACK STANDS

A CAUTION PINCH HAZARD!

To avoid possible personal injury keep hands and fingers free of moving parts when lowering the Jack Stand Posts.

- Once again, raise the vehicle properly with the jack to remove vehicle weight from Jack Stands and slightly beyond.
- Move Release Handle upward to release Pawl from ratchet teeth and lower Post.
- Remove Jack Stands from under vehicle.

NOTE: Always carry the Jack Stands by the Release Handle, not by the Post.
