INSTRUCTIONS



The **Eastwood 5" Vacuum Cup** is an excellent solution for pulling out minor dents in auto body sheetmetal or handling difficult to grip items such as body panels and glass.

SAFETY INFORMATION

A NOTICE

 Use Vacuum Cup only on clean, smooth, non-porous and non-textured surfaces.

ASSEMBLY

 Unthread Knob from threaded post at top of Vacuum Cup, place selected Eyelet over threaded post and tighten Knob securely

OPERATION

- Place Rubber Vacuum Cup against a clean, smooth, non-porous or non-textured surface.
- Depress the grey Plunger fully and repeatedly until it stays in and the red line is no longer visible.
- Suction cup is now ready to be used. DO NOT exceed 65 lbs. of lifting or pulling capacity as serious injury or property damage may occur.
- Release vacuum by pulling up rubber tab at the edge of the Cup.
- Always store with the Rubber Cup nested in the Protective Plastic Base.
